



How to use Mepitac®



Make sure the skin is clean, dry and free from any ointment, etc. Cut off the desired length of Mepitac® using scissors.



Remove the protective release film.




Apply Mepitac® without stretching. If inspection or repositioning is necessary, Mepitac® can be lifted and reapplied.

How Mepitac® works

Mepitac® is highly conformable and easy to apply and remove. The Safetac® layer ensures secure fixation and atraumatic removal from skin and hair. If inspection or repositioning is necessary, Mepitac® can be lifted and re-applied. It is an ideal fixation solution for patients with fragile and sensitive skin or with allergies to traditional adhesives. Mepitac® is suitable for patients requiring repeated application and removal of tape over the same area (e.g., neonates and dialysis patients).

The adhesion of Mepitac® may decrease when used in humid conditions such as incubators or on patients who are diaphoretic. Mepitac® is not suitable for fixation of arterial catheters and arterial cannulae.
